### **ENTRY FORM**

The Community Arts – Upcycled is open to all residents of Central Goldfields Shire Council and Avoca. Students from all schools within the CGS and Avoca are invited to participate.

- 1. Artwork accepted Any type of visual art or craft is welcome in this exhibition including: woodwork, photography, painting, drawing, ceramics, graphic art and textiles. You are welcome to enter one artwork per artist. We are encouraging artists to submit artworks that respond to this year's upcycled/recycled theme, those that do will be eligible for the Healthy Environments prize (see no 6. below for more details). Maximum size of artworks allowed will be at the discretion of the Gallery. Two dimensional artworks must also be in a 'ready to hang' state with suitable hanging wire securely attached to the work. To keep this exhibition current and exciting we ask that all submitted artwork must have been completed within the last 12 months.
- **2. Entry fee** \$8.00 (or \$5 concession) per artwork for adults, \$5 for youth entries, primary and secondary school student entries are free. If cost is a barrier please speak with Gallery staff.
- 3. Opening event All artists will be invited to an exhibition opening at 2pm on Saturday 29 November 2025
- **4. Youth Awards** sponsored by Maryborough Craft Shop Inc.: 1st prize \$50, 2nd prize \$30 and 3rd prize \$20. Open to primary and secondary school students in Central Goldfields Shire and Avoca. One entry per student.
- **5. People's Choice Award** A non-acquisitive prize of \$100 for the artwork that receives the most votes in this Award, to be announced at the end of the exhibition. The Youth Awards will be announced at the opening.
- **6. Healthy environments Prize:** This is a non-aquisitive prize of \$200, the winner's will have the opportunity to have their artwork displayed at Council for up to 12 months. This Award will be announced at the opening.
- 7. **Labelling** All artwork <u>must</u> be labelled on the back/underside of the work using labels supplied with the entry form (please attach labels to your artwork securely) otherwise your entry may not be accepted. Please complete the entry form and bring the form with you when you deliver your entry.
- **8. Delivery of work** Artwork must be delivered to the Gallery, between the 6-9 November 2025, between 10am–4pm (or at another time only by prior arrangement with Gallery staff).
- 9. Collection of work Artwork must be collected on 26, 27 February or 5, 6 & 7 March 2026 between 10am–4pm (an alternative time/day for collection can only be agreed by prior arrangement with Gallery staff). Anyone picking up artwork on behalf of an artist must have proof of authorisation from the artist and bring the Gallery artwork receipt (given to the artist on delivery) with them to enable release of the artwork.
- **10. Sale of artwork** The Gallery will offer artist's works on display for sale (unless marked *not for sale*) but will only refer potential buyers directly to artists to negotiate and process sales. In order for all visitors to enjoy the exhibition, artwork must remain at the Gallery on display until the end of the exhibition.
- 11. **Exhibition content** The Gallery has final decision over the content of the exhibition. Not all artwork may be installed, depending on space restrictions.
- 12. Photography/video permission By entering an artwork you also agree to your submitted artwork being photographed or filmed and allow any images/footage of it to be used by Central Goldfields Art Gallery or Central Goldfields Shire Council and media outlets for marketing and communication purposes in print or online this year or in the future.
- **13. Picking day at the Resale Shed:** Wednesday 2 July 2025. Ticket on next page will gain you entry to the Resale Shed on Wednesday 2 July between 10am–1pm to enable you to pick and purchase some discounted items. Resale Shed: 125 William Road Carisbrook.
